61 health education centres and **1** SCTC Smoking Cessation Counselling Centre in Slovenia

Density of smoking clinics

- 1 health education centre per 33 609 inhabitants
- 1 smoking cessation counselling centre per country

Typical smoking clinics procedure

Face to face and group cessation counselling.

Group counselling: 6 visits in 6 weeks; evaluation after 6 weeks, 6 and 12 months.

Face to face counselling: 5 visits, evaluation after the last visit.

Health professional in smoking clinic

- 1 or 2 **nurses** per health education centre
- 3 **medical doctors** and 3 **psychologists** for 61 centres to provide occasional counselling
- 1 **medical doctor**, 1 **psychiatrist**, 1 **head nurse** per counselling centre

Training for smoking clinic health professionals

A national **9 hour training** for specialists in tobacco dependence treatment under the auspices of Slovenian Public Health Institute, funded by HHS

Cost of smoking clinic visits

Visit to health education centre or smoking cessation counselling centre is **free of charge**.

Particularity of smoking clinics

SCTC offers free of charge group counselling at workplaces, schools and learning centres for young adults.

Good practice in smoking clinics

Uniform education for specialist in tobacco dependence treatment and group counselling.

Annual report of centre's activities and **evaluation** of its success.

Health education centres in **all regions** in Slovenia. Smoking Cessation Counselling Centre under SCTC's supervision provides a **medical doctor**, a **psychiatrist** and a **head nurse** for occasional counselling.

Bad practice in smoking clinic

Health education centres lack knowledge in counselling **young adults, prisoners, Roma**, and people with **psychological diseases**.

CO monitoring devices available only at SCTC.

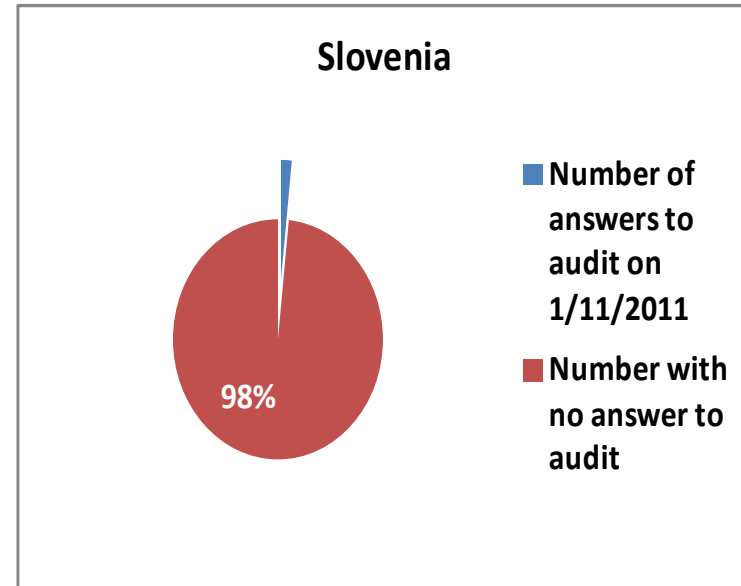

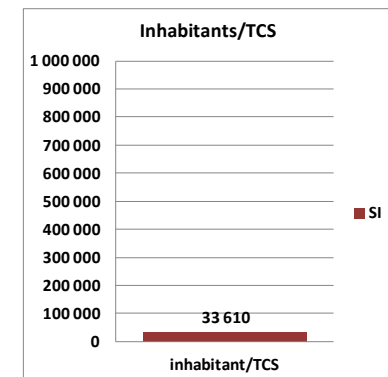

Comments

- ◉ In 2005, 2 health professionals from SCTC took part in CINDI national program for health promotion and chronicle non-contagious diseases prevention in primary health care. The program also included a 9 hour tobacco cessation course and was free of charge.
- ◉ Last year, 10 health professionals from SCTC NGO members also completed the first part of the program. The program was paid by SCTC.
- ◉ Even though SCTS was prepared to cover the cost of training in 2011, Slovenian Public Health Institute didn't give us a chance to apply. That is why we decided to introduce our own training for health professionals (medical doctors and registered nurses).
- ◉ **In 2011/2012, Ministry of Health of RS decided to financially support the SCTC Smoking Cessation Counseling Centre.**

- ◉ 62 TCs organized in Slovenia
- ◉ Mainly community health care centre based
- ◉ **Slovenian Public Health Institute** (Dominika Novak Mlakar, MD) insures coordination for 61 health care centers
